Our proposal for the 2022 Junior MUN

General Concept:

The idea is to create an MUN conference where the delegates would be local representatives of the Eastern Province.

We would like to invite schools from our province, both public and private, from the 4th grade to 8th grade. Participants will debate and work together to research and create solutions and ideas to promote sustainable development inspired by the Kingdom's 2030 Vision and the launch of the Saudi and the Middle East Green Initiatives. It will be a time designed specifically for collective reflection on challenges that should be taken up by this new generation. More than just finding solutions, delegates will be made aware of major challenges that the world faces including global warming, climate change along with the need to ensure sustainable development for our region and they must find ways to fight against these problems.

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MUN GENERAL PRESENTATION

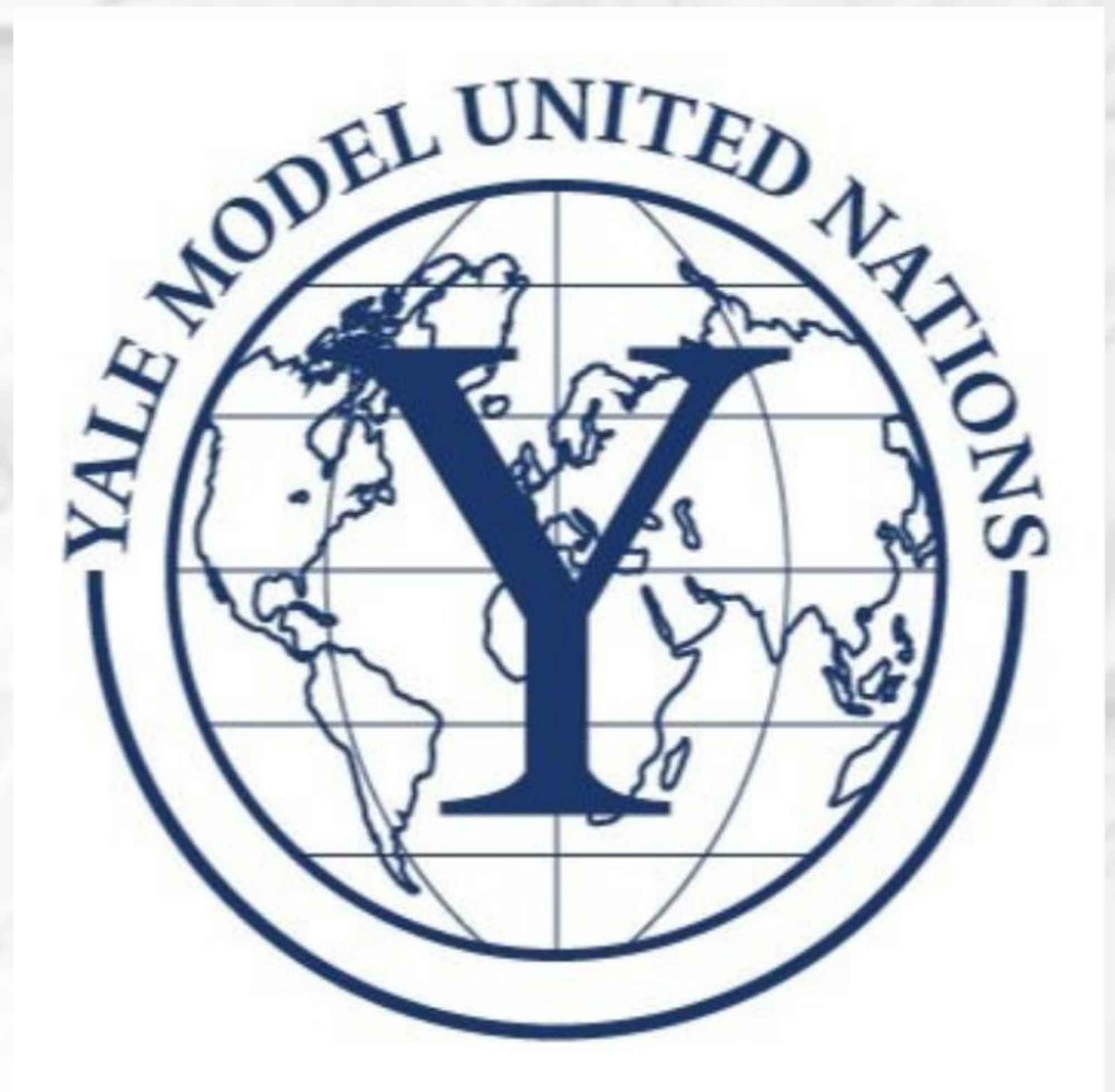
Model United Nations, also known as model UN or MUN, is an educational simulation in which students can learn about diplomacy, international relations, and the United Nations. At an MUN conference, students work as the representatives of a country, an organization, or a person and must solve a problem with other delegates. MUN teaches the participants how to research, speak, debate and write. Moreover, it teaches them how to acquire the skills and the essence of teamwork and leadership. It is meant to engage students and allow them to develop deeper understanding of current world issues.

Before any conference is held, the delegates first research their country's position on selected topics. Next, they must present statement's of their countries' positions and debate and negotiate with the other delegations, both formally and informally. Then, a resolution is written, debated, negotiated and amended in line with each country's interests and in response to the debate. Finally, votes are held on the resolution and a final resolution is produced.

The best-performing delegates in each committee, as well as delegations, are sometimes recognized with awards.

OUR MUN EXPERTISE

Our school has acquired an outstanding experience through the many MUN events in which we have participated: students have had the privilege of participating in the prestigious Yale and Harvard MUN as well as the Middle East MUN, the Cairo MUN and many others. Last February, our High School's MUN Club participated in the 68th Session of Harvard Model United Nations' Conference, a prestigious program that gathers high school delegates and their faculty advisors to address some of the world's most pressing challenges. Seventeen were recognized for their performance, representing the most successful and we are proud to announce that one of our student won the « Best delegate » award among 2600 students from 66 countries !



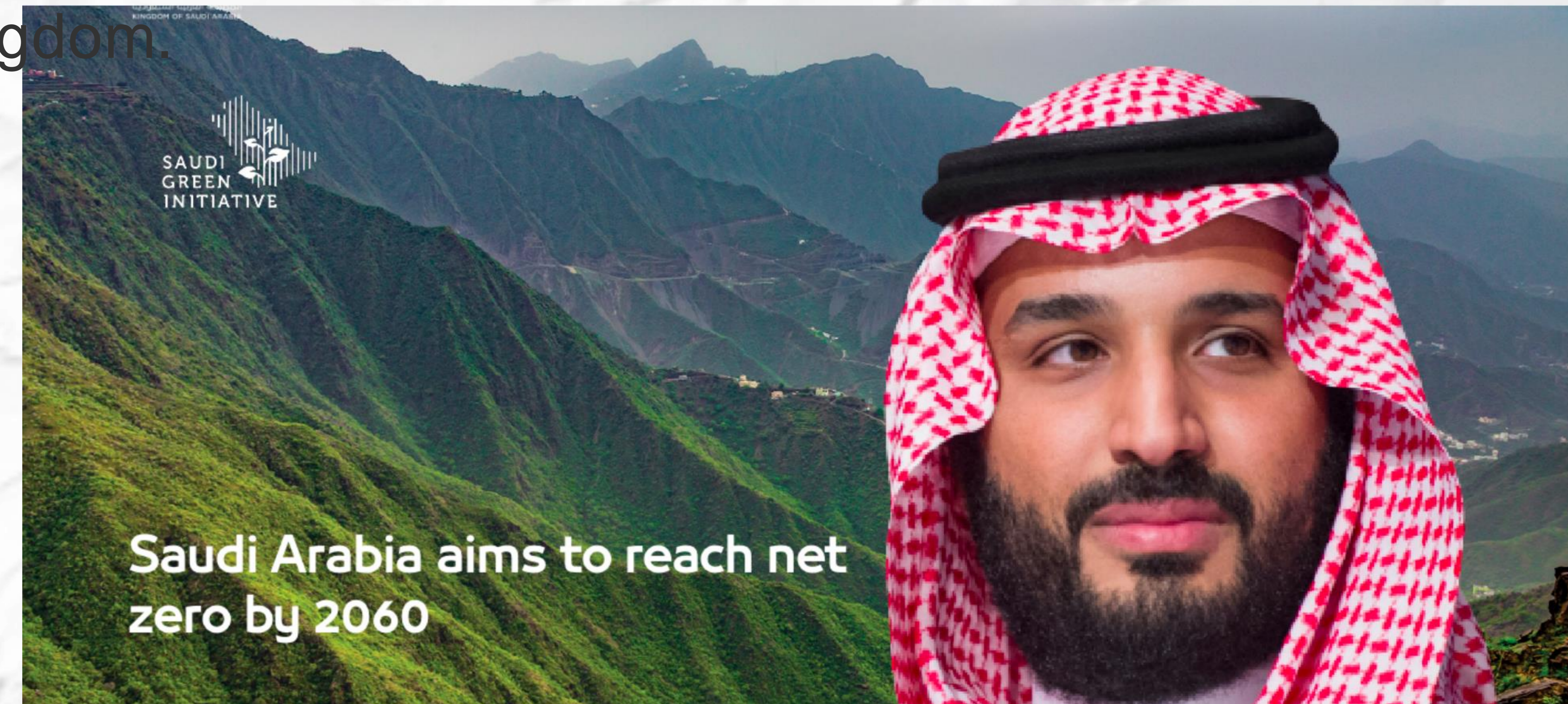
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Our proposal for the 2022 Junior MUN
